For the graph $y=x^{2}+2 x+3$
What is the value of $y$ when $x=-2$

Work out the gradient between the points

$$
(2,-3) \text { and }(5,6)
$$

Where do the lines $y=2 x-5$ and $y=7 x+5$ intersect?

The gradient of the line $A B$ is 2 . The line passes through the point $(3,5)$. Work out the equation of the line $A B$.

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
