

$$\frac{3}{5} \times \frac{7}{9}$$

When multiplying fractions, multiply the two numerators and multiply the two denominators.

$$\frac{3}{5} \times \frac{7}{9} = \frac{3 \times 7}{5 \times 9}$$

$$= \frac{21}{45}$$

Then simplify, here divide both numbers by 3

$$\frac{21}{45} \div 3 = \frac{7}{15}$$

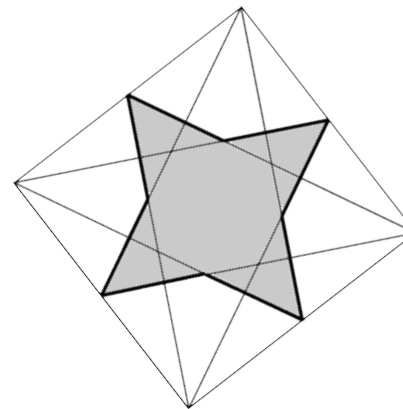
$$\frac{3}{5} \div \frac{7}{9}$$

When dividing fractions, flip one of the fractions and then multiply them!

$$\frac{3}{5} \div \frac{7}{9} = \frac{3}{5} \times \frac{9}{7}$$

$$= \frac{3 \times 9}{5 \times 7}$$

$$= \frac{27}{35}$$



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
